

Directions:

For those of you taking route 60 from the west Do not turn onto Ballsville Road from Route 60, go all the way to Trenholm. You will not be able to make the turn into the farm if you turn onto Ballsville Road from Route 60.

For those of you coming from the Charlottesville area, take Interstate 64 to the Zion Crossroads exit. You will take Route 15 south to Route 6, which is the most trailer-friendly route. This will eventually take you to Cartersville Road, Route 45. Take route 45 to Cartersville, and when you go through Cartersville, there will be a very sharp right turn. In that turn is a road to the left, Cartersville Extension. Turn left on Cartersville Extension. Stay on Cartersville Extension until you get to Pine Tree (yes, it is a real place), and you will bear right on Trenholm Road. Take Trenholm road to Ballsville Road on the right. The Farm is about 1.5 miles on the left.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

ENTRY FEES: \$25.00 per class pre-entry, \$ 30 post-entry, and Hunter Divisions \$60. Post entries will be after 6 pm the day before the show. **OFFICE FEE \$15.00**

COGGINS TEST: All exhibitors must present a negative Coggins Test report on each animal exhibited within one year. This is a Virginia State Law. Please bring an extra copy to leave with your entry at EACH HORSE SHOW. THANK YOU.

SCHOOLING: Will be permitted only in the ring at designated schooling times, and there will be a warm-up area available.

ATTIRE: All exhibitors must wear ASTM/SEI protective helmets with harnesses fastened at all times while mounted on the show grounds.

AWARDS: The judge's decisions are always final. Six ribbons per class. Champion Trophy and Ribbon and Reserve Champion Trophy and Ribbon in each division. We will also provide series Champion and Reserve. These awards will be given at the last show, and you must be present to receive your award.

Jumper Divisions

Warm-up one trip over a specified course will be allowed. Unjudged.

Tadpoles - Open to juniors and amateurs only. A course of ground poles. Riders cannot cross-enter.

Cross rails- Open to junior and amateurs only. Cross rails not to exceed 18'. (0.6 meters)

Puddle Jumper: Open to horses and ponies. Horses, ponies, and riders may only cross-enter into any class not exceeding 3' if otherwise eligible. Fences 2'-2'3" (.75 meters) shall not exceed the height of the fence. All classes must be held under USEF Table II 2C Power and Speed or any USEF Optimum Time. **Novice Jumper**: Open to horses and ponies in their 1st or 2nd year of showing in Jumper classes at 2'6" or higher as of December 1 of the current show year. Horses and ponies in this division may only cross-enter into Novice Children's/Adult Amateur Jumper if the rider is eligible, TB Jumper and Low Jumper, and any other class not exceeding 3'. Fences' 2'6" Spreads shall not exceed the height of the fence. (.85 meters)

Novice Children's/Adult Amateur Jumper: Open horses and ponies ridden by Children and Adult Amateurs in their 1st or2nd year of showing in Jumper classes at 2'6" or higher as of December 1 of the current show year. Riders may only cross-enter into Novice Jumper, if mount is eligible, TB Jumper and Low Jumper, and any other class not exceeding 3'. Spreads shall not exceed the

height of the fence. (.85 meters)

Low Jumper: Open to horses and ponies. Fences 2'6"-3' Spreads shall not exceed the height of the fence. (.85 -.95 meters

Open Jumper: Open to rider's horses and ponies. Spreads shall not exceed the height of the fence. 2'6" (.85 meters)

Thoroughbred Jumper: Open to registered Thoroughbreds and those eligible to be registered. 2'6"-3' (.85-.95meters) Spreads shall not exceed the height of the fence.

Junior/Adult Amateur Jumper Equitation: Open to Juniors and Adult Amateurs. To be judged on hands, seat, guidance, control, and optimum time. Numerical scoring. 2'6"-3' (.85-.95 meters) Spreads shall not exceed the height of the fence.

Children's/Adult Amateur Jumper: Open to horses and ponies are ridden by juniors and adult amateur riders.2'6"-3'3" (.85-1.00 meters)

Schooling Jumpers: No restrictions on horses or ponies, or riders. 3'3"-3'6" (1.00-1.10 meters) spreads not to exceed the height of the fence.

Modified Jumpers: No restriction on horses/ponies or riders. 3'6"-4' (1.10-1.20 meters) Spreads not to exceed the height of the fence.

California Warm-up: unjudged, only one trip per horse/rider combo <u>Hunters</u> <u>ONLY</u>

Lead line: Open to riders seven years and younger as of December 1 of the current show year. Riders are not allowed to cross-enter into any trot classes.

Pre-Short Stirrup Equitation: Open to riders 10 years and under as of December 1 of the current show year. Riders may not cross-enter into canter or jumping classes.

Short Stirrup EQ: Open to riders 12 years and under as of December 1 of the current show year. Riders may not cross-enter into classes with jumps higher than 18". Courses may be trotted.

Short Stirrup Hunter: Open to riders 12 years and under as of December 1 of the current show year. Riders may not cross-enter into classes with jumps higher than 18". Courses may be trotted.

Long Stirrup Hunter: Open to juniors or amateurs. Trotting and trotting changes are permissible. Riders may not cross-enter into any class over 18".

Student Equitation: Open to riders in their 1st or 2^{nd} year of showing 2['] or higher as of 12/1/2022. Courses may be trotted.

Pleasure: Judged on manners, suitability, soundness, and way of going. Ponies must be ridden by Juniors.

Equitation on the Flat: Open to Juniors and Adult Amateurs. May be split into Juniors 14 and under, Juniors 15-17, and Adult Amateur.

Limit Rider Hunter: Open to horses/ponies ridden by Juniors/Adult Amateurs. Riders may not cross-enter into Equitation over fences classes or any class with fences 2'6" or higher. Ponies must be ridden by juniors. Horses and ponies may cross-enter.

Special Hunter: Open to Horses or Ponies. May trot or canter over fences. **Green Hunter**: Open to Horses in their 1st or 2nd year of showing over fences 2'6" or higher. It can be combined with Green Pony if entries warrant. **Green Pony Hunter**: Green Pony is a pony of any age in his first year of showing in any classes that require ponies to jump the designated height for green pony. (Ponies are only allowed to show one year as Green Ponies). A pony's green status is not affected if the pony has not been shown at more than four (4) competitions prior to September 1st and if it was not shown at that height after September 1st in the same year.

Pony Equitation: Open to Juniors on ponies. Jump heights: Small 2'; Medium 2'3"; Large 2'6".

Pony Hunter: Open to Ponies 14.2 hands & under-ridden by juniors. Jumps: Small 2'; Medium 2'3"; Large 2 6".

Children's/Junior Equitation: Open to Juniors mounted on horses. Minimum Jump height is 2'6"; not to exceed 3'

Children's Hunter: Open to Horses ridden by Juniors. The minimum Jump height is 2'6" not to exceed 3'

Adult Amateur Equitation: Open to Adult Amateurs mounted on horses. Minimum Jump height is 2'6"; not to exceed 3'.

Adult Amateur Hunter: Open to Horses or Ponies not showing in any Pony Division ridden by Adult Amateurs. Minimum Jump height is 2'6" Thoroughbred Hunter: Open to registered TBs and horses eligible to be

registered. No restrictions on riders.

Schooling Hunter: Open to Horses and Ponies; no restriction on riders. Minimum Jump height is 2'6"; not to exceed 3'.

Working Hunter: Open to all Horses, and Ponies not showing in any Pony Division. Minimum Jump height is 2'9"

Ladies Side Saddle: Open to horses and ponies ridden side saddle by junior or senior. Must be ridden in side saddle and habit. Jumps 2'3'' - 2'6''

Horse Show Release, Assumption of Risk, Waiver and Indemnification

This document waives important legal rights. Read it carefully before signing. I AGREE in consideration for my participation in this Competition to the following: I AGREE that the "Competition" as used above includes all of their officials, officers, directors, employees, agents, personnel, volunteers and affiliated organizations. I AGREE that I choose to participate voluntarily in the Competition with my horse, as a rider, driver, handler, vaulter, longueur, lessee, owner, agent, coach trainer, or as parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor. I am fully aware and acknowledge that horse sports and the Competition involve inherent dangerous risks of accident, loss, and serious bodily injury including broken bones, head injuries, trauma, pain, suffering, or death ("Harm"). I AGREE to hold harmless and release the Federation and the Competition from all claims for money damages or otherwise for any Harm to me or my horse and for any Harm of any nature caused by me or my horse to others, even if the Harm arises or results, directly or indirectly, from the negligence of the Competition. I AGREE to expressly assume all risks of Harm to me or my horse, including Harm resulting from the negligence of the Competition. I AGREE to indemnify (that is, to pay any losses, damages, or costs incurred by) the Competition and to hold them harmless with respect to claims for Harm to me or my horse, and for claims made by others for any Harm caused by me or my horse while at the Competition. I have read the Rules about protective equipment, including GR801 and, if applicable, EV114 and I understand that I am entitled to wear protective equipment without penalty, and I acknowledge that the Competition strongly encourages me to do so while WARNING that no protective equipment can guard against all injuries. If I am a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor, I consent to the child's participation and AGREE to all of the above provisions and AGREE to assume all of the obligations of this Release on the child's behalf. I represent that I have the requisite training, coaching and abilities to safely compete in this competition. I AGREE that if I am injured at this competition, the medical personnel treating my injuries may provide information on my injury and treatment to the Competition.
